<u>Prep before Mass:</u> Please arrive at least 10-15 minutes before Mass. Come to the sacristy (where the priest and servers get ready) and put an alb and cincture (rope) on.

Note on Posture: Please have good posture (stand and sit up straight). If you are standing or walking and not carrying anything, please fold your hands.

# **Mass**

### **Introductory**

- 1. After the singing begins for the opening song, the servers process in (one with cross first followed by the other server).
- 2. They stop at the foot of the altar leaving space for the priest (and deacon) to stand between them.
- 3. When the priest genuflects, the server with the cross bow his head and the other server genuflects. The cross is placed in the cross-stand and the servers stand at their pew.
- 4. Toward the end of Gloria, the priest will step away from his chair. At this point, a server brings the Book to the priest for the Opening Prayer.

#### **Preparing the Altar**

After the prayers of the faithful, the priest will go to the altar.

- 5. Using both hands one server brings the main chalice and places it on the altar.
- 6. If there are other vessels (small chalices, patens, or pyxes) these are brought the altar.
- 7. One server accompanies the priest/deacon to receive the gifts in front of the altar.
- 8. The server will be handed the wine cruet by the priest/deacon. The other server will get the water from the credence table. The servers will stand next to the altar ready to hand the water and wine to the priest/deacon.
- 9. After receiving their cruets back, the servers get the water, bowel, and towel, to wash the priest's hands.

#### **Eucharistic Prayer**

10. One server rings the bell 3 times when the priest raises Host and 3 times when the priest raises the Chalice.

#### Communion

- 11. During the sign of peace, extend peace to the priest (shake his hand).
- 12. After the priests distributes Communion and places the Eucharist in the tabernacle, one server brings the water cruet to altar.
- 13. The servers take any items placed on the side of the altar and return them to the credence table.

#### **Concluding**

- 14. When the priest stands, one server brings the Book to the priest for the Closing Prayer.
- 15. When the priest moves toward the altar during the closing hymn, one server gets the cross. Both servers then go and stand in front of the altar.
- 16. When the priest genuflects, the server with cross bows his head and the other server genuflects.
- 17. The cross-bearer leads the procession to the sacristy.
